Sweetwater Class Policy

Sweetwater makes every effort to maintain the schedule of classes indicated in the catalog, however, we reserve the right to change and/or cancel classes.

Summer Camp Cancellations:

- Cancel 14 or more days before camp starts → Receive a full refund.
- Cancel less than 14 days before camp → Receive a class credit (no refunds)
- No refunds or credits for missed days due to illness, vacation, or schedule conflicts.
- Class credits are non-transferable and may only be used toward future class tuition.

Late Registration: Students may register for any classes, after the start date, space permitting and with approval from the instructor.

Canceled Classes: If a class is canceled due to low enrollment, inclement weather, or other circumstances beyond the center's control, students will be notified at least 48 hours in advance. In such cases, students will receive either a full refund to their original payment method or a class credit toward a future course.

Student Absences: Sweetwater does not offer make-up classes, tuition reimbursement, or prorated tuition for classes a student is unable to attend.

Withdrawals and Dropped Classes

Students who wish to withdraw from a class must do so at least five (5) business days prior to the start date of the class.

- Withdrawals made five or more business days before the start date are eligible for a refund.
- Withdrawals made less than five business days before the start date are eligible for class credit only.
- No refunds or credits will be issued without at least five days' notice.
- Class credits are non-transferable and may only be applied toward future class tuition.

Accessibility

Sweetwater welcomes individuals with disabilities to our facility and is committed to providing the best access possible to our events and programming. We encourage questions, requests, and suggestions to help us achieve our ongoing goal of creating a comfortable, enjoyable environment suited to all unique needs and abilities.

Building: Accessible entrances to our building include the Bank Street entrance and Sweetwater's parking lot entrance. The Bank Street entrance may be used to access the lower level of our building. The parking lot entrance may be used to access the upper level of our building. Once inside the building, the upper and lower levels are only connected via stairs. Accessible restrooms are available on each level. Due to the nature of our historic building, Sweetwater's gallery, located on the mezzanine, is not accessible for persons with limited mobility.






