

SCHURMAN FINE ARTS FUND

CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

Through the initial generous support of the W.P. Snyder Foundation, we have officially launched a campaign to renovate our artistic spaces within the Old Sewickley Post Office. As our impact continues to grow, so must our creative spaces to allow for new, innovative and equitable programming. Our goal is to raise at minimum \$1,000,000 in capital funding for the building by the end of 2028.

SWEET RIDE

Early next year, we will unveil Sweet Ride, our new mobile art unit. Designed in collaboration with Leanne Ford and supported by several local and regional foundations, this initiative aims to reach low-income and marginalized communities in our area, bringing the joy and power of art directly to those who need it most. Additionally, once launched, we will also open the mobile unit as a new art party option for the community, allowing Sweet Ride to come to you! Look out for Sweet Ride in May of 2025.

Established to elevate the adult and teenage curriculum at the Center, the Schurman Fine Arts Fund is dedicated to enriching our educational programming through high quality teaching artists, equipment and training. The fund is responsible for the continuation of our master class series, and supplying all materials for our introductory classes.

THE OLIVER FAMILY ENDOWMENT

Established in memory of Sweetwater founding patrons David and Laura Oliver, The Oliver Family Endowment creates a sustained future for Sweetwater Center for the Arts. The endowment will provide continual support to the Center, focusing on Four Pillars as its foundation. Currently, Sweetwater is 40% the way to our goal of \$1,000,000 by 2030.

Registration

Sweetwater encourages you to register online. Students may set up an online account at sweetwaterartcenter.org/classes, or you may also register in person at the Sweetwater office and by phone. Payment is due upon registration. Sweetwater does not hold a spot in a class until payment is received.

<u>Late Registration:</u> Students may register for any classes, after the start date, space permitting and with approval from the instructor.

<u>Sweetwater Class Policy:</u> Sweetwater makes every effort to maintain the schedule of classes as indicated in the catalog; however, we reserve the right to cancel classes.

Cancellations & Refunds: Sweetwater does not offer make-up classes or tuition reimbursement for student absenteeism. Sweetwater does not prorate tuition for classes that the student cannot attend. If Sweetwater must cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment, registered students will be notified 2 days before the start date, and tuition will be reimbursed. If the student must cancel their enrollment in a course, the following cancellation policy will apply: Class cancellations must be made at least 3 business days before the start date of the class. Students may receive a refund OR a credit voucher for the full amount if they cancel no less than three business days before the class start date. No refunds or credit will be given without 3 business days notice. Credit vouchers are non-transferable between students and may only be applied toward class tuition.

Accessibility

Sweetwater welcomes individuals with disabilities to our facility and is committed to providing the best access possible to our events and programming. We encourage questions, requests, and suggestions to help us achieve our ongoing goal of creating a comfortable, enjoyable environment suited to all unique needs and abilities.

Building: Accessible entrances to our building include the Bank Street entrance and Sweetwater's parking lot entrance. The Bank Street entrance may be used to access the lower level of our building. The parking lot entrance may be used to access the upper level of our building. Once inside the building, the upper and lower levels are only connected via stairs. Accessible restrooms are available on each level. Due to the nature of our historic building, Sweetwater's gallery, located on the mezzanine, is not accessible for persons with limited mobility.








Specialty Workshops



In early summer of 2024, major gift contributors Carol and Gary Schurman established Schurman Fine Arts Fund to advance the adult curriculum at Sweetwater.

The fund will play a significant role in providing the artists at the Center with the proper tools, instructors, and curriculum to advance in their careers. The fund will allow Sweetwater to work with specialty instructors, purchase appropriate equipment, and develop a progressive curriculum in all areas of visual arts.
