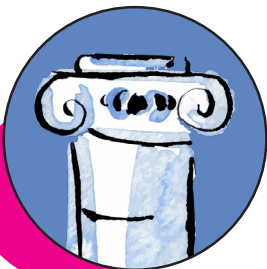
## SWEET RIDE

# Registration

*Sweetwater encourages you to register online. Students may set up an online account at [sweetwaterartcenter.org/classes](http://sweetwaterartcenter.org/classes), or you may also register in person at the Sweetwater office and by phone. Payment is due upon registration. Sweetwater does not hold a spot in a class until payment is received.*

**Late Registration:** Students may register for any classes, after the start date, space permitting and with approval from the instructor.

**Sweetwater Class Policy:** Sweetwater makes every effort to maintain the schedule of classes as indicated in the catalog; however, we reserve the right to cancel classes.

**Cancellations & Refunds:** Sweetwater does not offer make-up classes or tuition reimbursement for student absenteeism. Sweetwater does not prorate tuition for classes that the student cannot attend. If Sweetwater must cancel a class due to insufficient enrollment, registered students will be notified 2 days before the start date, and tuition will be reimbursed. If the student must cancel their enrollment in a course, the following cancellation policy will apply: Class cancellations must be made at least 3 business days before the start date of the class. Students may receive a refund OR a credit voucher for the full amount if they cancel no less than three business days before the class start date. No refunds or credit will be given without 3 business days notice. Credit vouchers are non-transferable between students and may only be applied toward class tuition.

Due to the nature of our historic building, Sweetwater's gallery, located on the mezzanine, is not accessible for persons with limited mobility.
